

Supply List for Border of Roses

- Appliquick Tools
- Appliquick Glue
- Scissors that cut to the tip
- Thread to match your applique (I prefer 100 weight silk or 80 weight cotton as these threads hide your stitches)
- Needle size 10 or 11 either between, applique or straw
- Thimble Pad by Clover (I prefer these to thimbles as a metal thimble tends to cut the thread)
- Small ruler (approximately 1.5" x 6.5")
- White Chalk pencil
- Inexpensive size 8 or 10 flat brush

One to two yards of border fabric (depending on how large your quilt is) The pattern for the border is 12" wide.

One to two yards of fabric for roses and circles. You choose what color you wish your roses to be.

Several fat quarters of greens for leaves and stems
