# Fused Applique Octopus Garden Pattern

<u>Please complete your background to fuse against before class!</u> <u>Water- 20.5</u>" vertically x 24.5" wide <u>Sand - 2.5</u>" x 24.5". Straight sew the sand and water section together or machine piece or appliqué sections together with slight curves.

Pressing sheet for fused appliqué if you have one. Parchment paper works too.

- Large ziplock bag.
- 1 yard of Lite Steam a Seam 2.
- paper scissors.
- Optional Sea Fan kit for adding a 3- D element to your coral reef. Instructor will have in class.

## Turned edge Sea Turtle and Coral Reef.

We will just make the turtle in class - using unit appliqué. You do not need a background!

#### EASY Apliquick Turned Edges. I will be teaching this method in class.

# Bring your own Apliquick tools or purchase from instructor in class or order from my website when you order your pattern.

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Threads to match fabrics for your turtle 60 weight or higher. Appliqué pins.

- 4 inch or small size, sharp pointed scissors for cutting small complex shapes.
- Instructor has appliqué scissors for purchase.

You do not need to make this before class. but you may if you want to., Water - 32 x 21 background light water batik. Sand -1/4 yd. light sandy beige to add along bottom.

<u>Attach</u> sand section to the water with gentle curves. Option 1. Turn under 1/4" seam allowance with Starch, and appliqué to water. 2. Slight curved piecing.
