Wall Hanging <i>(pictured back)</i>	30 x 30"	20 FEs or Layer Cake	4 FQs	--	¾ yard	¼ yard
Throw <i>(pictured front)</i>	60 x 60"	Ten ¼ yards or Layer Cake	Four 1 yard	--	3½ yards	½ yard
Twin	60 x 90"	Fifteen ¼ yards	Six 1 yard	--	5½ yards	⅝ yard
Double/Queen	90 x 90"	Twenty ¼ yards	Nine 1 yard	--	8¾ yards	⅔ yard
King	110 x 110"	Twenty ¼ yards	Nine 1 yard	3 yards	9¾ yards	⅞ yard

* FQ is a Fat Quarter. FE is a Fat Eighth.

Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary Cutter
- 12" Rotating Cutting Mat *(optional)*
- Quilting Ruler - Creative Grids 18° Dresden Ruler

Sewing Machine Supplies:

- Sewing Machine in working order. Please come with fresh needle/full bobbin (with piecing thread).
- Thread for Piecing (Neutral color, thin thread, Aurifil preferred)
- Monofilament Thread (optional for blind machine appliqué)
- Lingerie Thread (optional for blind machine appliqué)
- Silk Thread (optional for hand appliqué)
- Microtex Sharp Needle for Piecing

Additional Supplies:

- Frixion Pen or marking pen of your choice
- Appliqué Needles

Traditional Sewing Supplies: Pins, Seam Ripper, Scissors etc.
