

Hand Quilting

Learn how to incorporate hand quilting to add depth and interest to your quilts. In this class students will learn the basics of hand quilting, including using different types of thread (cottons, metallics, rayon).

Bring a closely basted quilt to work on. You can also opt to add hand stitching to an already machine quilted quilt.

Level: Beginner

Supply List

-Basted quilt. For lap quilting you will want to baste closely, 3-4" apart. You can also opt to add hand stitching to an already machine quilted quilt.

-Small scissors

-Thread (perle cotton size 8 or 12)

-Variety pack of needles: Embroidery or Sharps

-Non-permanent marking tool (chalk pencil recommended)

-Acrylic ruler at least 12" long (to help draw quilting guides)

-Thimble that fits snug on finger tip (should not fall off when you move your hand)

-Needle threader

-Thread conditioner

-Safety pins for additional basting

-Painters tape (optional-can be used as a quilting guide)

-Quilting hoop (optional)
