



Creating Contrast with Free Motion Quilting

- Sewing machine set up for Free Motion Quilting. All demonstrations will be done on a domestic sewing machine. However if you are a quilter who prefers to work on a longarm, feel free to do that in this class. Adjust the supply list as necessary.
- Three or Four approximately 18" square quilt sandwiches with solid white or very light coloured fabric on one side (the back side can be any fabric you want to get used up! Please leave one of these sandwiches un-sandwiched as we will be doing some marking on it during class.
- White or very light coloured thread to exactly match the solid fabric on your quilt sandwiches
- Black quilting thread
- A bright or medium shade of quilting thread
- Bobbins to match all three quilting thread colours
- Printed out line drawing of a flower (type "flower line drawing" into google and pick one you like. Should print to fill a sheet of paper.
- Thread snips
- Marking Pen
- Straight ruler you can use for marking (such as a rotary cutting ruler)
- Something you can use to mark 2-3 inch circles (longarm quilting ruler, drafting supplies, thread spools, whatever you can find)
- A 2" x 12" piece of solid dark coloured fabric
- Basic Sewing Supplies
