

## Elongated Hexagon Runner, and Set of Two Quilted Place Mats

Slow down, relax, and use your fabric stash to create English Paper Pieced hand sewn elongated hexagons, a variation on the hexagon. Learn how to sew them together with a flatback stitch to make a runner or a strip for either place mat! A demonstration on hand quilting by Michele will show you how to finish the runner. With easy piecing, and machine quilting, Michele will show you how to complete both place mats.

\* Please note that this is a FUN, stress free technique class; and the project will not be finished in class.

**Skill level:** Advanced Beginner > Intermediate

**You must know how to accurately measure; use a rotary cutter; and know how to sew an accurate 1/4" seam on your sewing machine.**

**Kit includes:** Thirty 1 3/8" x 1" elongated hexagon paper templates (can be reused for the runner and/or either place mat); and the quilt pattern to make all 3 projects.

**Kit cost:** \$11 plus shipping

### Materials List for the EPP Elongated Hexagons

- ~ Hand sewing needle that is comfortable for you
- ~ Small spool of cotton thread for basting (any color)
- ~ Water soluble *fabric* glue stick

- ~ 1" x 6" acrylic ruler
- ~ Paper tape - medium (I recommend Nexcare by 3M at Target)
- ~ *If needed or desired*: 3 mini Wonder clips; a thimble; portable light; magnifying glass; and/or bifocals.

**To complete the Runner** – 12" x 14 3/4"

- ~ Sixty-three 2" x 3 1/2" assorted strips of fabric (elongated hexagons)
- ~ 1/8 yard of fabric (binding)
- ~ 16" x 19" piece of fabric (runner back)
- ~ 16" x 19" piece of cotton batting
- ~ Sewing thread – to match and/or coordinate with the fabric
- ~ Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- ~ Basic sewing supplies

**To complete (1) Place Mat A** – 13 1/4" x 18 1/2"

- ~ Nine 2" x 3 1/2" assorted strips of fabric (elongated hexagons)
- ~ One 13 1/4" x 18 1/2" fabric rectangle (place mat front)
- ~ One 15" x 20" fabric rectangle (place mat back)
- ~ 1/8 yard of fabric (binding)
- ~ One 15" x 21" piece of cotton batting
- ~ Sewing thread to match
- ~ Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- ~ Basic sewing supplies

**To complete (1) Place Mat B** – 13 1/4" x 18 1/2"

- ~ Nine 2" x 3 1/2" assorted strips of fabric (elongated hexagons)
- ~ One 4" x 13 1/4" strip of fabric (contrasting color from the place mat front)
- ~ One 13 1/4" x 18 1/2" fabric rectangle (place mat front)
- ~ One 15" x 21" fabric rectangle (place mat back)
- ~ 1/8 yard of fabric (binding)
- ~ One 15" x 21" piece of cotton batting
- ~ Sewing thread to match
- ~ Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- ~ Basic sewing supplies
