

# Make a Leap for it

Finished Size: 17" x 24"

## Description:

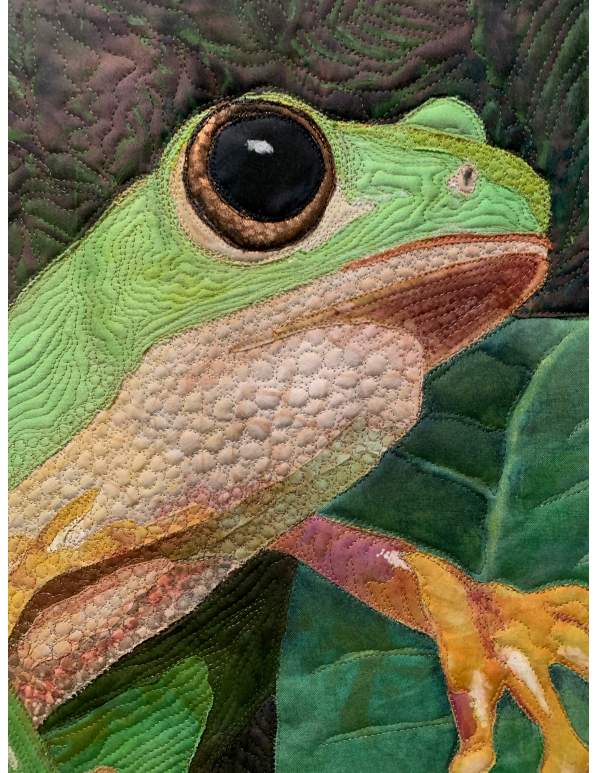
This is a raw edge appliqué art quilt, with directions for adding a small amount of ink or color pencil that make the quilt really pop into a realistic art.

## Supply List:

### Fabric:

All recommended amounts are a fat quarter (FQ) or small piece (SP). A small piece is generally 8" square. I recommend you choose either a solids, hand dyes, or batik fabric for this project.

Frog green (FQ)  
Leaf green (FQ)  
Bright green ((FQ)  
Dark Green (SP)  
Light tan ((FQ)  
Black/Dark blue for eye (SP)  
Speckled tan to light yellow belly (SP)  
Yellow Orange to Mauve (FQ)



Background fabric: A batik, dark brown or similar, cut 19" by 26"

Ink: I use All Purpose Ink by Tsukineko

Colors used in this project: White #80, Bright Copper #73 Sand #52 Chocolate #54 and Thyme #66.

Additionally you will need a bullet point Fantastix brush by Tsukineko for each color, and a brush point Fantastix brush for the Copper Metallic ink.

Color Pencils: I recommend a set of high quality pencils, with at least 24 colors by Prisma, or Faber-Castell or similar quality pencil.

Misty Fuse adhesive, 3-4 yards (12" wide to 20" wide).
