Panel – of course! Bring a panel you would like to work with – any style is great.

Single frame panels are great and we can work with those of course as there is a lot to learn about using one of those, but if you want to challenge yourself, choose a panel with several different sized sections for a more challenging design process.

12 inch graph paper – I prefer the paper by June Tailor that has 4 squares per inch and is 12 x 12 on the pad.

Mechanical pencil

Calculator

Drafting ruler (not a rotary cutter ruler – school rulers are perfect)

Design surface or portable design wall (optional)

Camera or cell phone with camera feature

Books or magazines or other sources for lots of block ideas  
iPad or laptop for design inspiration

Scrap paper for rough sketching of ideas as well as doing math and taking notes.

Colored pencils –optional

Coordinating fabrics

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Iron and Ironing surface

Spray starch, Bet Press or Sizing

H2O spray bottle
