

Beneath the Surface – Supply list

Materials:

Makes three small quilts:

- 3, 12" squares backing fabric
- 3, 12" squares low loft white batting
- 3, 12" squares fine weave white fabric
- 2, 10" squares colored fabric

For facings:

- 12, 3 ½" squares backing fabric
 - 12, 8" x 3" strips backing fabric
- Optional: fusible web tape

Embroidery thread (8wt. perle cotton to co-ordinate with chosen colored fabrics)
White thread for quilting (50 or 60wt e.g. Aurifil on the Orange cone, Efina from Wonderfil)

Equipment:

- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Iron and ironing board
- Freezer paper
- Pins
- Sewing machine with walking foot (built in dual feed system works well... use a ¼" foot). Bobbin wound to match top thread.
- 80 sharp (Microtex) needle
- pencil

Useful: lint roller, low tack painters' tape
