

Understanding the Value of Color Supply list

This is a no-sew workshop!

There will be a slide show presentation at the beginning of class to help give you information and clarification of the class topic.

You will need:

- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Two office supply type Glue Sticks (Denison, Elmers's etc. - make sure that they are NOT repositional type. Permanent type is preferred)
- Paper and pen for note taking
- Iron and pressing surface

Easy access to your fabric stash. Have the list below within easy reach for the class, and if needed, you can always grab something from your stash during class. Don't depend on being able to "shop" from your stash during class -- or you'll end up spending all of your precious class time trying to pick what you want.

- You will use lots of different fabrics for this class, so you'll need your fabric to be organized by color.
- Within each color family (i.e. Red, Blue, Green, etc.), You will need lights, medium lights, mediums, medium darks and darks.
- You will need several prints that are monochromatic -- monochromatic means one color.
- You will need several white fabrics (tone on tone prints, off white included) and black prints (black and white, black and gray, black and beige, etc.)
- You will need a couple of multicolored prints to use as a color palette.
- Choose a monochromatic set of 7 fabrics -- one color in a gradation from light to dark.
