

Supply List – Hand Hewn Log Cabin – Katrina Walker

Students wanting to create the class project as illustrated and explained in the class materials should plan to use:

Fabric:

Reversible, crisp (stiff) fabric such as linen, cotton batik, silk dupioni, or silk organza. **Natural fibers only.**
1 Jelly Roll, or several strips of fabric 2.5"-3" wide by width of fabric. Variety of colors is recommended. 3 strips minimum. An additional square of 4"x4" wide may be used for the center of the piece. If the fabric is not reasonably crisp it will need to be well starched before using.

Thread:

50 or 40 weight silk or polyester thread that coordinates with fabric.

Tools:

Hand sewing needle. I prefer millinery needles or beading needles. You may find it most comfortable to have a selection to choose from as you learn.

Needle threader

Thread conditioner, such as Thread Magic

Thimble (optional, but good for sensitive fingers)

Fabric cutting scissors or rotary cutter, mat, and ruler

Clear ruler suitable for marking 1/2" lengths (12" length is plenty)

Fabric Folding Pen, Hera marker or similar tool for making creases (available from Clover-usa.com)

Fine pins or Wonder Clips

Thimble (optional)

Snip-EZE or similar suitable for trimming threads
