

Moonrise - Curves Workshop

In this workshop, we are taking a scientific approach to accurate piecing, and learning how to sew inset curves. You can choose to make either of the 2 pattern sizes.

Supplies

Fabric	Notions
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Ugly fabrics that you don't mind sacrificing for science: 2 fat quarters or equivalent in large scraps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Rotary cutter with a fresh blade<input type="checkbox"/> Cutting mat<input type="checkbox"/> Quilting ruler, minimum 6½" square<input type="checkbox"/> 50 or 80 weight thread<input type="checkbox"/> Seam ripper<input type="checkbox"/> Chalk pencil<input type="checkbox"/> Pins<input type="checkbox"/> Washable glue stick
<p>Wall Hanging Size (40"x42"):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Sky: 3/4 yards<input type="checkbox"/> Water: 2 fabrics, ½ yard each<input type="checkbox"/> Moon: 5 fat quarters	
<p>Throw Size (60"x63"):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> Sky: 1½ yards<input type="checkbox"/> Water: 2 fabrics, ⅞ yard each<input type="checkbox"/> Moon: ½ yard main plus 4 fat quarters for highlights/shadows	<p>Optional but very helpful:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><input type="checkbox"/> 28mm rotary cutter<input type="checkbox"/> Seam guide or 1/4" presser foot<input type="checkbox"/> Large square ruler<input type="checkbox"/> Spray starch

Preparation

In preparation for this workshop, please bring all the items in the **Supplies** list and have your fabrics chosen and numbered. Our goal is to piece and assemble at least one quarter of the moon and one column of water blocks.

Before class, please:

- Starch and press all of your fabrics.
- Follow cutting instructions in the pattern (pg. 3-4 for Wall Hanging Size, pg. 5-6 for Throw).
- At a minimum, have **Fabrics 4, 5, 6, 7** cut, along with **1 strip of each size** from **Fabrics 2, 3**.
- If you can cut more ahead of time, you'll be able to focus on piecing during the workshop.
