

Diamonds on a String Class Supplies



Diamonds on a String:

A variety of fabric strips varying in width from 1 ½" to 3" wide and at least 11" long equal to approximately ½ yard total to make 1 diamond block.

(1) strip white or white on white fabric 1 ½" wide x width of fabric (40" or longer.)

(4) squares solid fabric 5 "x 5" for diamond centers

(2) sheets copier paper 8 ½" x 11"

Basic sewing supplies (seam ripper, pins, marking tools, scissors, etc.), sewing machine in good working order with ¼" foot, rotary cutter with new blade and mat.

Mechanical Pencil

Glue Stick or Tape Runner

12 ½" square ruler and 24" ruler helpful.

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
