

Supply List – Introduction to Modern American Pojagi – Katrina Walker

Students will need the following materials to create samples for the class book:

Fabric:

Crisp, reversible fabrics, such as cotton batik, linen, or silk dupioni.

Cut 11 strips of fabric, 5"x16". Batik jelly roll strips may be used instead. Natural fibers strongly recommended. 2 of the strips ideally should be silk organza but not required.

Thread:

40 or 50 weight machine sewing thread and bobbin

Tools:

Fabric cutting scissors

Snip-EZE, applique scissors, or similar – suitable for trimming fabric close to stitching

Clear ruler at least 12" long, suitable for marking ½" wide lengths.

Fabric Folding Pen, Hera marker, or similar tool for creating creases (available from clover-usa.com)

Fine pins (optional)

Seam Ripper (optional)

Glue stick (Elmer's washable is fine)
