

Through Thick or Thin Supply List

- 5/8 yard of six fabrics in light, medium, and dark values (see Note).
- Twin size batting
- Color Evaluator
- Sewing machine with 1/4" setting or foot
- Thread for piecing
- Machine needles
- Scissors
- Iron and ironing surface
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, ruler (6" x 24" and 6 1/2" square)

Note: Fabric for this quilt should be at least three colors/values. The most effective quilt is made with at least 6 colors, with three distinct values (light, medium, and dark). Do not choose all colors of the same value. Include at least one-third very light fabrics, one-third medium fabrics, and one-third very dark fabrics. Use the Color Evaluator to ensure that you have three sets of fabric of different values.
