

Create A Scrappy EPP Hexagon Pieced Quilt!

Slow down, relax, and use your fabric stash to create hand sewn hexagons! Michele will teach you a quick and easy way to create the ever popular English Paper Pieced (EPP) hexagons! Learn how to sew them together with a flatback stitch to make either a heart or egg! Michele will teach you how to complete each quilt; and use small seed beads (if desired). * You will decide whether you want to make the heart or egg quilt, but Michele will show you how to make each of these quilts!

* Please note that this is a FUN, stress free technique class; and the project will not be finished in class.

Skill level: Beginner > Intermediate (for EPP)

You must know how to accurately measure; use a rotary cutter; and know how to sew an accurate 1/4" seam on your sewing machine.

Kit includes: Fifty 3/4" hexagon paper templates (can be reused for either/both quilts); and the quilt pattern to make both quilts.

Kit cost: \$12 plus shipping

IF you are making either the Scrappy Heart Quilt or the Scrappy Easter Egg Quilt, you will need these items for creating the hexagons:

- ~ Hand sewing needle that is comfortable for you
- ~ Small spool of cotton thread for basting (any color)

- ~ Water soluble *fabric* glue stick
- ~ 1" x 6" ruler
- ~ Paper tape - medium (I recommend Nexcare by 3M at Target)
- ~ ***If needed or desired:*** 3 mini Wonder clips; a thimble; portable light; magnifying glass; and/or bifocals.

Materials List to Complete the Scrappy Heart Quilt – 14 ½" x 15 ½"

- ~ Thirty-three assorted scrappy red 2" x 2" squares - (*please measure and cut accurately*)
- ~ 1/8 yard of red fabric (border)
- ~ 1/8 yard of red/white fabric (binding + sleeve)
- ~ 3/8 yard of white tonal (quilt center, border + corner squares)
- ~ 17" x 18" piece of fabric (quilt back)
- ~ 17" x 18" piece of cotton batting
- ~ Sewing thread to match
- ~ Machine quilting thread – white
- ~ One package of clear or white seed beads (if desired)
- ~ Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- ~ Basic sewing supplies
- ~ Sewing machine with an accurate 1/4" foot

Materials List to Complete the Scrappy Hexie Easter Egg Quilt – 15" x 16 ½"

- ~ Assorted scrappy 2" x 2" squares: 7 green; 8 yellow; 8 lavender; 12 pink; and 13 blue (*please measure and cut accurately*)
- ~ 6" x 6" square of lavender (bow)
- ~ 18" x 20" piece of fabric (quilt back)
- ~ 1/6 yard of fabric (border)
- ~ 1/8 yard of fabric (binding + sleeve)
- ~ 3/8 yard of white tonal (quilt center + corners)
- ~ 6" x 6" square of fusible web light
- ~ 18" x 20" piece of cotton batting
- ~ Sewing thread to match
- ~ Machine quilting thread - white
- ~ Embroidery thread – 1 skein of lavender
- ~ One package of clear seed beads (if desired)
- ~ Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat
- ~ Basic sewing supplies
- ~ Sewing machine with an accurate 1/4" foot
