



Supply List for Designing Paper Pieced Curves Workshop

Purchase required kit from my Etsy shop:

Supplies:

Print templates—at least six of the square template and 4 of the rectangular template (I used copy paper)

Mechanical pencil

Colored pen or Pencil

Eraser

Rulers: straight edge at least 12” long, Soft Ruler/Arbitrary Curve Ruler/Flex Design Curve Ruler (in kit), Add A Quarter Ruler (optional if you like to use one for paper piecing, I do not)

Sewing Machine

90/14 Sewing Machine Needle (Superior Titanium Coated Topstitch Needle in kit)

Thread for project (Aurifil Cotton 50wt recommended)

Pins (Clover Flower Head pins in kit)

Seam Ripper

Fabric Scissors

Paper Scissors

Rotary Cutter

Cutting Mat

This project works really well with a two color palette. I would recommend a yard each of two solids. You can get away with a little bit less but this allows you to go a bit bigger, or to have enough for the binding. A textured solid or a small scale print that reads as a solid would be effective. I discourage directional prints for this project.

To finish the project, you will need a 20 ½” square of batting, 20 ½” square of backing fabric, basting pins or spray, and quilting thread.
