

BABY BLOCKS QUILT© 60" x 60"

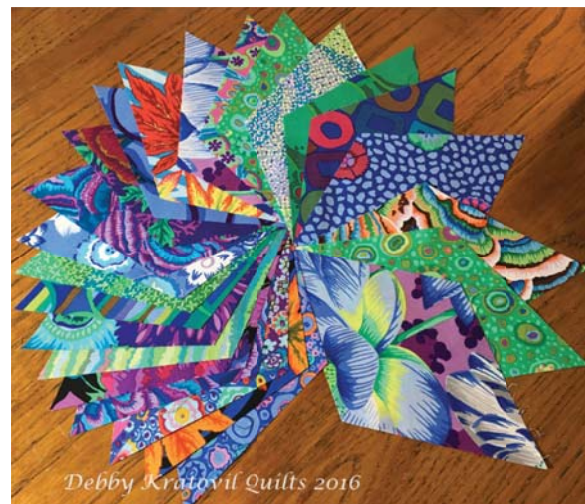


The traditional Baby Blocks pattern uses 60 degree diamonds and is stitched using a y-seam. My Baby Blocks technique takes out that y-seam altogether. All straight seam sewing. We work some magic with those light background pieces and you will be delightfully surprised at how easy and quick this quilt goes together.

Please bring your strips pre-cut (both the background fabric and your fabrics for the colored diamonds). DO NOT attempt to cut your diamonds (as shown here below). We do all that in class.

Materials you will need:

- Assorted 4-1/2" strips of prints to yield 84 diamonds. Note: each 4-1/2" x wof strip will yield 7 diamonds. Twelve (12) strips will give you the needed 84 diamonds. For more variety, dig into your stash! This equals AT LEAST 1-1/2 yards.
- 1-1/2 yards blue/white background print (or your choice). Cut several 4-1/2" strips; we will cut the background triangles in class.
- 1/3 yard gold (or preferred color) for inner border
- 2 yards border print
- 1/2 yard print for binding
- 3 yards backing
- 68" x 68" batting (or size requested by longarm quilter if that is how you wish to finish this)
- Standard 6" x 12" acrylic ruler with marked 60° lines
- I strongly suggest a multi-sized 60° triangle ruler with a flat tip, with at least a 6-1/2" height. See next page to compare your own ruler.



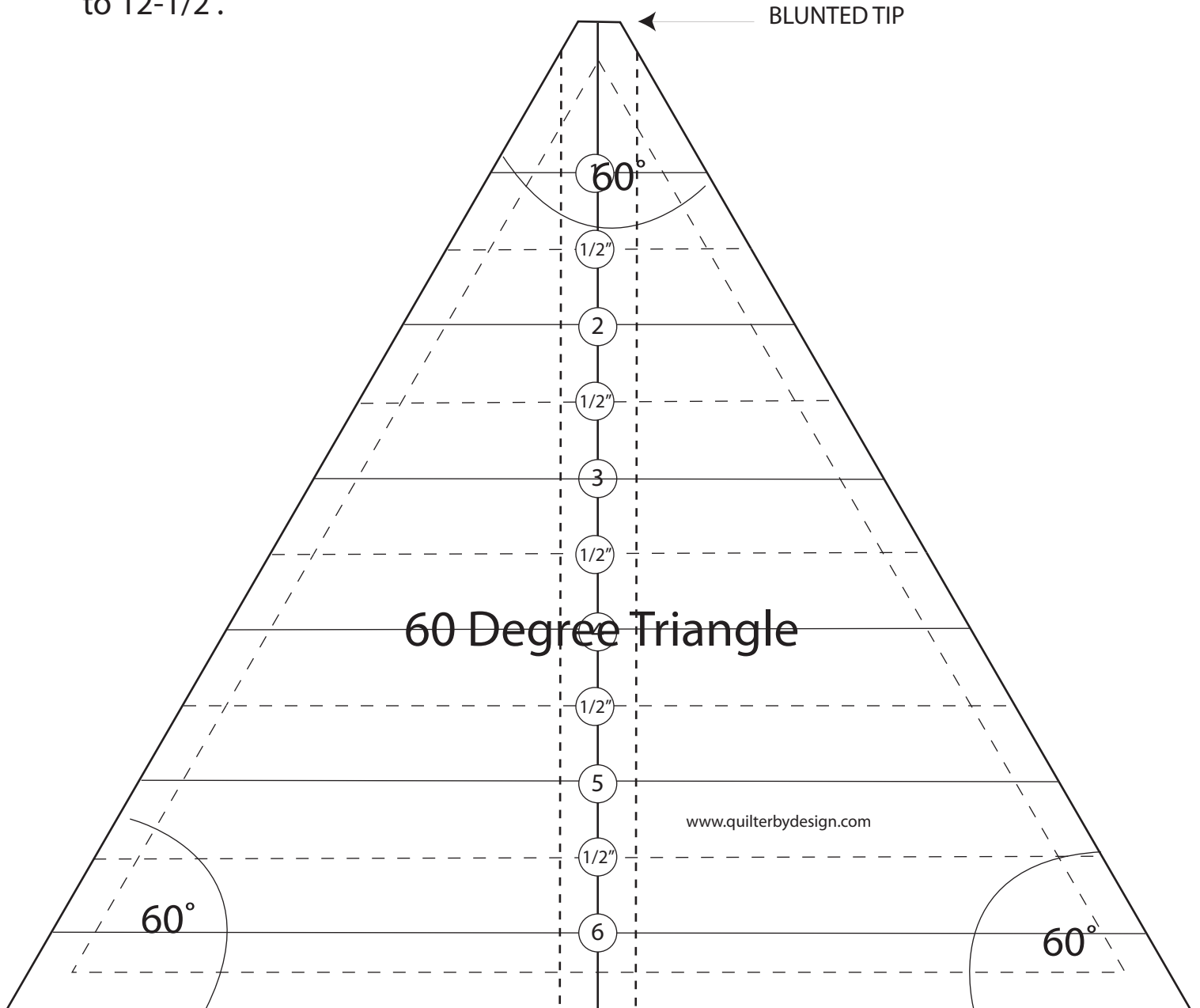
This quilt uses a total of 84 diamonds

60 degree equilateral triangle ruler
The distance from blunted tip to
bottom of ruler must be at least 6-1/2".
Most rulers are a standard 8-1/2" up
to 12-1/2".



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
