

Retro TV Pincushion Supply List

Let's stitch up a fun retro style TV pincushion in stitch friendly wools. There are three different styles of TV to choose from. And wait until you see the "secret sauce" to making the legs!

Required Materials:

- TV Time Pattern
 - Available for purchase at www.tamarinis.com
 - Kits are also available for purchase at www.tamarinis.com
- Patience
- A sense of humor

Fabric: (colors from the pattern are listed, but choose your own awesome color scheme)

Wedge TV:

- Cream wool: (1) 3 ½" x 4" rectangle (TV screen and (3) ¼" circles)
- Light Green wool: (1) 8" x 14 ¾" rectangle (TV)
Cut (1) 1 ¾" x 14 ½" rectangle
- (2) small Bead Cones
- (2) large Bead Cones

Circle TV:

- Cream wool: (1) 4" square (TV screen and (3) 1/8" circles)
- Orange wool: (1) 7" x 12" rectangle (TV)
Cut (1) 1 ¾" x 11 ¼" rectangle
- (4) small Bead Cones

Oval TV:

- Cream wool: (1) 3" x 4" rectangle (TV screen and (3) ¼" circles)
- Blue wool: (1) 7" x 10" rectangle (TV)
Cut (1) 1 ¾" x 9 ½" rectangle
- (4) small Bead Cones

Sewing Supplies:

- Sewing Machine (don't forget your power cord and foot pedal)
- Thread
- Scissors
- Rotary Cutter
- Rotary Mat (18" x 24" or larger)
- (1) Sheet Steam-A-Seam 2 Light per pincushion
- Coordinating Aurifil 12wt or 28wt thread
- E6000 glue
- 4 wooden skewers per pincushion
- Fiberfill
- Hemostat
- Awl

Before session, please:

- Cut all fabrics per the pattern. Label your cuts by size for quick piecing.
