# Sugar and Spice

Learn how to make traditional Lemoyne Star blocks the Studio 180 way. You'll actually use strip piecing and oversizing as you build the block sections, then trim to high precision sections for easy and accurate blocks everytime! We'll be making 6" finished size blocks for our Sugar and Spice project, but with the required tool you'll be able to make Lemoyne Stars in any of 10 different sizes from 3" to 12" finished. It's really quite addicting!

We'll also be learning how to make build a quilt using an on-point setting, why and how to cut side setting triangles and corner setting triangles, and how to construct a "scrappy" freeform border.

You will be required to purchase the pattern and the Rapid Fire® Lemoyne Star tool, unless you already own it. The Tucker Trimmer® I tool is highly recommended. The current cost for both tools and pattern are set at \$60.00 total. Arrangements can be made to rent tools for the day if you would simply like to try before you buy, but please note, the project will not be able to be completed without them.

Please note precutting is also required for this class, so come prepared. There is no time alloted for the cutting of the required pieces during the workshop!

# Fabric and Pre-Cutting Requirements

Precutting will allow you to make several samples of the Lemoyne Star blocks, half square triangle blocks, and quarter square triangle blocks. There will be additional cutting required for you to be able to finish your project.

#### Lemoyne Star Blocks

From each of eight different color coordinated, medium to dark value fabrics cut:

Cut 1 strip 2" x approx 20" (total of 8 strips)

From Cream background fabric cut:

Cut 4 strips 3¼" x width of fabric

## Setting Blocks and Triangles

From assorted medium to dark value fabrics cut: Cut 3 assorted colored squares 7½" x 7½" (hourglass) Cut 4 assorted colored squares 7" x 7" (half square)

From Cream background fabric

Cut 1 square 7½" x 7½"

Cut 4 squares 7" x 7"





# **Equipment and Supplies**

### **Required Tools:**

- Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star® tool available
- Tucker Trimmer® I available in class
- Invisigrip (for underside of ruler) available in class
- Sewing Machine in good working order (unless you are attending a machine sponsored class. Please check with your event coordinator for details)
- Neutral Colored Thread
- Mat 12" x 18" recommended
- General purpose cutting rulers a 6" x 12" and a  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " or larger square ruler
- Basic Supplies such as Scissors, Pins, Seam Ripper, etc.
- Rotary Cutter new blade recommended

#### Optional:

- Additional light source
- Chair pad or cushion
- Extension cord
- Camera
- Notebook & pencil
