

Supply List for Lucy Boston

*Acrylic templates used to cut your fabric shapes.

* Paper templates used to shape your fabric around.

* Water soluble glue stick if you wish to glue your fabric to your paper shapes (this is the fastest method)

Basting thread if you would rather not use glue

* Double stick tape (I use Res-Q-Tape)

* Thimble or Clover Thimble Pad

Rotary cutter and mat

* One Wonder Clip

Thread to match your fabric

A fine needle (size 10 or 11) you are comfortable with and that fits the thread you chose

Scissors

If you are planning to fussy cut you will want fabric with repeats. Some with 4 repeats and some with 8. A focus fabric or a border print with mirror images works very well. Choose a couple although we will probably only complete one or two in class.

In addition to the focus or border print fabric you will want 2 – 4 coordinating fabrics.

You will also wish to choose a background fabric but will not be used in class. It may be best to wait until you have completed several blocks and then audition a background.
