



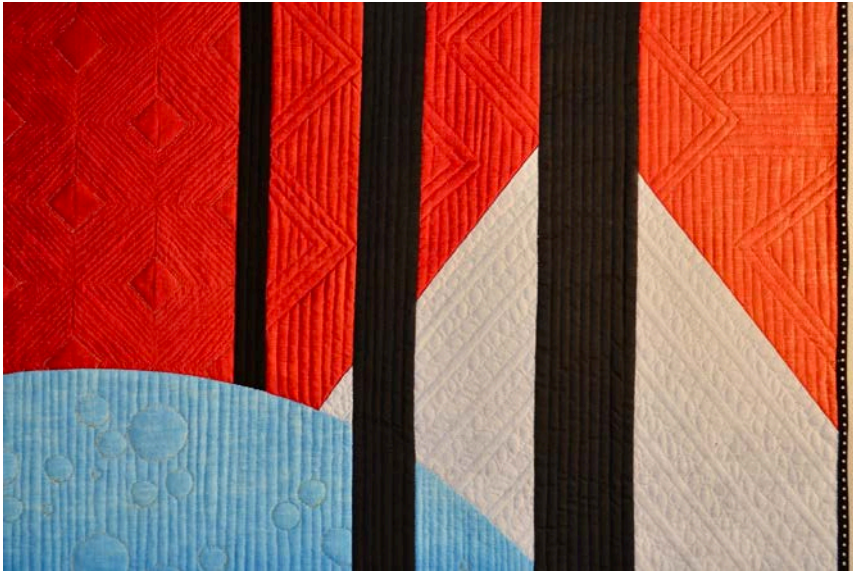
Sewing Machines for this class are provided by Juki and Moore's Sewing Center.

Modern quilting designs add a delightful, often unexpected visual layer of interest. They float under traditional pieced blocks or appliqué shapes and often include more straight lines than traditional quilting. Kathy will review tips for needles, thread and tension, etc. for domestic machines. We will practice 5 designs

used for fillers and learn to

create your own thread quilted creatures too. I will review ruler work and you have time to practice if you bring your own machine quilting rulers.

### Supplies from home

9 mm chalk marking pencil or air erase marking pen.

9 inch square omni grid ruler, for marking shapes.

6 sheets white computer paper.

Small scissors.

Bring your own plain or UFO block quilt sandwich for practice

Top, batting and backing — pin basted Sandwich -minimum of 16 x 16" maximum 22 x 26". You can always bring two or three to practice different designs.

60 weight thread to match background fabric.

40 weight contrasting color threads.

80/12 needle
