

Supplies to Bring to Class:

- **Fast, Fun & Easy® Fabric Dyeing book by Lynn Koolish (recommended)**
- **Rubber gloves**—dishwashing type
- **Dust mask**—N95 recommended

- **Fabric**— different types of fabric will yield different results; good quality fabric works best
 - Any 100% plant-based/cellulose fiber can be used—this includes cotton, rayon, linen, and hemp. You can also use silk. You can bring yardage and/or garments. dharma trading.com is an excellent source
 - You can also bring light-colored commercially printed or previously dyed fabric to over-dye.

Important: If possible, prewash all fabric (even PFD) in detergent or Synthropol or Dharma Textile Detergent & hot water—don't use fabric softener or dryer sheets.

Bring 3–5 yards of fabric, you can also bring pre-hemmed scarves, garments, or household items such as napkins.

!! Do not bring polyester, nylon, any other synthetics or blends, or fabric that is permanent-press!!

Note: you will be taking wet fabric from class that will need to be washed and dried when you have time.

Other Supplies:

**** If you are travelling by air and cannot bring some of the supplies such as containers, buckets, and paper towels, just bring what you can, extra supplies will be available.*

- At least 2 plastic containers with a wide mouth and screw-on lid that does not leak when shaken vigorously—options include condiment squeeze bottles and recycled food containers—just make sure the opening is large enough to fit a spoon into and that they don't leak when shaken
- If you can bring them: 6–8 one-pint (6 - 8 oz) size plastic containers and 5–6 one-quart (32 oz) size plastic containers, such as recycled yogurt & cottage cheese containers—just bring what you have, don't worry about exact sizes; no glass jars please

- Scissors
- Set of measuring spoons NOTE: these cannot be used for food after they have been used with dye
- Measuring cup (1 -2 cups is good)
- 2 gallon size zip-type plastic bags to dye in and to take wet fabric from class (10 - 12 of them)
- 2 – 3 plastic spoons
- If you can bring it: 1 bucket/container, 1–2½ gallon size
- If you can bring them: Roll of paper towels
