

# Rapid Fire® Hunter's Star

Get ready to experience a fantastic new way to construct traditional Hunter's Star quilts. You will use a strip piecing technique to make everything slightly oversized, so you can then trim the blocks to an exact size.

We will play with design and layout to create unique designs rarely seen in other workshops.

During the class, you will be able to construct some or all of the blocks required for a wallhanging or table runner. This will only happen if you are properly prepared. ***Please make sure to bring fabric strips precut and ready for sewing.*** There is no time allotted for cutting strips when you arrive at class.

## Fabric and Pre-Cutting Requirements for Table Topper or Runner

### Two Color Option:

Choose one dark and one light value fabric

¾ yard of each

Cut the same strips from EACH fabric

2 strips 6" x wof

2 strips 1¾" x wof

3 strips 2¼" x wof

### Three Color Option

Choose two fabrics that will create the background (usually one dark and one light) and one accent fabric for the star points (it should contrast with both background fabrics)

½ yard of each

Cut the following from each of the two background fabrics:

2 strips 6"

2 strips 1¾"

Cut from the accent/star point fabric

3 strips 2¼" (extra can be used for borders)



## Equipment and Supplies

### Required Tools:

- **Rapid Fire® Hunter's Star - Petit Star tool\***
- Sewing Machine - in good working order (unless you are attending a machine sponsored class. Please check with your event coordinator for details)
- Neutral Colored Thread
- Cutting Mat - 18" x 24" recommended
- General Purpose Cutting Ruler - 6" x 12" recommended
- Basic Supplies such as Scissors, Pins, Seam Ripper, etc.
- Rotary Cutter - new blade recommended

### Optional:

- Additional light source
- Chair pad or cushion
- Extension cord
- Camera
- Notebook & pencil
- Treats for the Teacher - who wants an "A"?
