Country Fair

Companion pattern for
Wing Clipper® I and Square Squared® tools

My *Country Fair* design is a scrappy version of the Carpenter's Wheel block. It is created with Flying Geese and Diamond Squares units to simplify the construction but maintain the same appearance. Use of two patented tools, namely the **Wing Clipper® I** and **Square Squared®**, will increase everyone's efficiency and accuracy when making the individual units, thus insuring a much higher success rate with this project.

Each student can expect to create at least one full size block and samples of the sashing and borders during class time. You can begin work on the generous twin size pattern project or simply cut what you need to do a one block wall size quilt. Either way, you'll have the opportunity to learn some innovative machine piecing tricks.

Precutting is required for this project. Please come prepared. There is no time allotted in class for cutting the required starting shapes. The small, one block, blue version shown in the photo can be made with the precut fabric amounts. For the larger, twin size total yardage information, please consult the back cover page for the *Country Fair* pattern on our website - **studio180design.net**.

Fabric and Pre-Cutting Requirements

Note - Precutting is given for a single block, plus some border sample units. Additional cutting and fabric are required to make the twin size project. For complete list of yardage for a twin size quilt, see the pattern listing on our website - **studio180design.net**.

From single, light background fabric cut:

- 2 squares - 5½" x 5½" (Block Geese)
- 4 squares - 3½" x 3½" (Square Squared)
- 24 squares - 3" x 3" (Border Geese)
- 4 rectangles - 2½" x 4½" (setting)
- 12 squares - 2½" x 2½" (four patches + setting)

From a wide variety of dark scraps cut:

- 6 squares - 5½" x 5½" (Border Geese)
- 1 square - 4½" x 4½" (Center square)
- 8 squares - 3¼" x 3¼" (Square Squared)
- 14 squares - 3" x 3" (Block Geese)
- 12 squares - 2½" x 2½" (four patches + setting)

Equipment and Supplies

Required Tools:

- **Wing Clipper® I Tool**
(available from the instructor)
- **Square Squared® Tool**
(available from the instructor)
- Sewing Machine - in good working order (Unless you are attending a machine sponsored class. Please check with your event coordinator.)
- Neutral Colored Thread
- Mat - 12" x 18" recommended
- Basic Supplies such as Scissors, Pins, Seam Ripper, etc.
- Rotary Cutter - new blade recommended
- 6" x 12" basic cutting ruler
- Pigma Pen or mechanical pencil (fine line marker)

Recommended Tools and Equipment:

- **Quilter's Magic Wand™**
- Invisigrip (for back of rulers)
- Extension cord
- Additional light source
- Chair pad
- Notebook & pencil
- Camera
