Fabric

- Prints Fabric A, B & J: 3/4 yard of each
- Prints Fabric D: 1/3 yard
- Prints Fabric C, E, F, G, H, I, K & L: Fat Quarter of each (8 total)
- Background: 2 3/4 yards

Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary Cutter
- 12" or smaller rotating mat (optional)
- Fabric Scissors
- Ruler

Sewing Machine Supplies:

- Sewing Machine in working order
- Thread for Piecing (Neutral color, thin thread; Aurifil 50 wt recommended.)
- Microtex Needle for Piecing

Appliqué Supplies: (optional, supplies will be available to try)

- Silk Thread for Hand Appliqué
- Monofilament for Machine Appliqué
- Bobbin Thread for Machine Appliqué (Bottom Line or Lingerie Thread)
- Freezer Paper
- Wonder Under or Steam a Seam
