# No-Sew Color For Quilters

This is a fun, **no-sew** class filled with surprises and lots of discussion. You will play with color and value as you glue fabric to paper to make pieced blocks. Everyone puts their blocks together and we all get to see what works, what doesn't, and most importantly, how to make color work for you.

This class is suitable for all skill levels.

### Fabric

Cut **FOUR 4" x 4" squares of each of the following colors.**

Choose from prints, tone-on-tones, or solids. Bring more if you'd like to have more choices.

**Medium blue**

**Dark blue**

**Green**

**Light green**

**Cheddar**

**Yellow**

**Orange**

**Red**

**Pink**

**Purple**

**White**

**Gray**

**Paper:** Bring 36 - 4"x4" squares of plain paper. (TIP: You can cut 4 squares per 1 standard sheet of paper.)

**Glue Stick:** An inexpensive school glue stick is fine.

**A small rotary mat, ruler, and cutter.**
