



Quilt Design in Illustrator

Designing quilts in Illustrator is efficient and FUN. Being able to ask questions of your quilt designs and seeing those questions answered before you cut any fabric or make any stitches is exhilarating and invaluable.

Each participant needs their own (no sharing please):

- Laptop Computer
- Charging cord
- Subscription to the Creative Cloud (trial subscription is acceptable)*
- Notebook for taking notes
- Two or three hand drawn examples of quilt ideas that you'd like to explore in a digital format
- (Optional: lightweight extension cord. A power strip is not necessary)

**Previous versions of Illustrator are acceptable, but some PC versions (for example, CS5 or CS6) will have an interface that looks very different from the Creative Cloud interface. If an older version of Illustrator is used, the teacher can not guarantee a smooth experience or stop the class to problem-solve issues).*

YOU MUST SET UP YOUR CREATIVE CLOUD SUBSCRIPTION BEFORE THE START OF CLASS. Please email daisy@warmfolk.com if you have difficulty setting up a subscription to the Creative Cloud.

The class covers a full range of quilt topics including piecing, applique, embroidery, and quilt motif design. Exercises will vary in degrees of difficulty. The class is structured with lectures that build on each other throughout the day, and participants of all levels and interests will be occupied during the entire class time.
