

EPP Stars & Pines Supply List

An English Paper Piecing Class
by Becky Goldsmith — Piece O' Cake

Finished block size: 8" x 8"

Finished quilt size: 40" x 40"

\$5 Required Class Kit that includes:

- 12-page handout that includes 3 pattern pages printed on card stock to make EPP papers
- A sampling of 3 of my favorite needles for EPP.

Fabric Requirements for 1 Star Block

You will need a variety of large scraps, up to 12" x 12". If you repeat or fussy-cut any fabric, you may need larger pieces of those fabrics.

Refer to the diagram for fabric placement. Shapes 8 and 9 can be combined as well as shapes 4 thru 7.

- 1 — star points
- 2 and 3 — very light background
- 4, 5, 6, and 7 — light medium to light
- 8 and 9 — block corners

Supplies

- Sharp paper scissors
- Sharp fabric scissors
- Rotary cutter, ruler, mat
- Quilter's Select glue pen and glue refills
- Sewing needle of your choice, in case you don't like the needles I give you.
- 2-5 Mini Wonder Clips by Clover (you won't need many in class)
- Basting thread: 40wt cotton, King Tut by Superior or similar
- EPP thread: I recommend Superior's Masterpiece 50/2 cotton on pre-wound bobbins and/or Aurifil 80/2 cottoning colors to match your fabric.

Optional but nice to have

- Needle threader
- Sandpaper board
- Thimble and/or adhesive finger protectors (I use Leather Thimble Pads)
- Wooden cuticle stick and/or Appliquick Rods
