Framed 60

Step up your game and learn how to construct our Framed 60 units using my **Star 60°** tool. This 3 hour workshop will cover the basics of how to construct a basic Framed 60 unit and then how to create simple stars, pieced triangles, and potentially, a striking pieced table topper.

The **Star 60°** tool is truly one of a kind. It is the only tool in the industry that allows for oversize construction then trimming for high precision shapes. This philosophy works for quilters of all levels. It is certain to increase everyones success rate and decrease the stress level.

During the workshop, each student can successfully build at least one small hexagon star or a multi-unit pieced triangle. The pieced triangle unit can then be duplicated 5 more times and stitched into the attractive table topper project measuring 20" from edge to edge.

Prior experience with the **Star 60°** tool is recommended, but not required.

The precutting instructions include enough fabric to make one table topper with few cutting errors. If you are new to the Star 60 process, you may want to bring along some extra fabric in case of missteps.

The Star 60 Tool and Framed 60 Technique Sheet are required for this workshop.

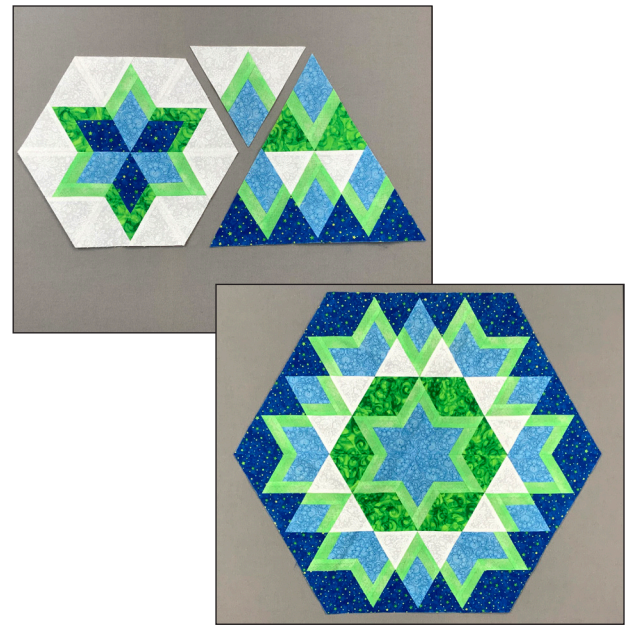

Use the coloring diagram to plan alternate color placement. Make sure to label your strips as either:

1) diamond strips, 2) framing strips, or 3) side triangle strips. This will be very helpful in a class situation.

To also help avoid confusion, please stay with a 5 fabric grouping for class.

Equipment and Supplies

Required Tools:

- **Star 60°** Tool
- Framed 60 Technique Sheet
- Invisigrip™ - to place on the back of your **Star 60°** tool
- Sewing Machine - in good working order (unless you are attending a machine sponsored class. Please check with your event coordinator for details)
- Neutral Colored Thread
- Cutting Mat - approximately 12" x 18"
- Rotary Cutter - new blade recommended
- General Purpose Ruler - approximately 6" x 12"
- Basic Supplies such as Scissors, Pins, Seam Ripper, etc.
- Ultra Fine Line Sharpie™ Permanent Marker

Optional:

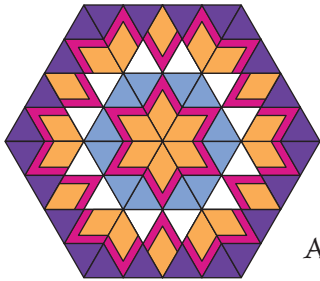
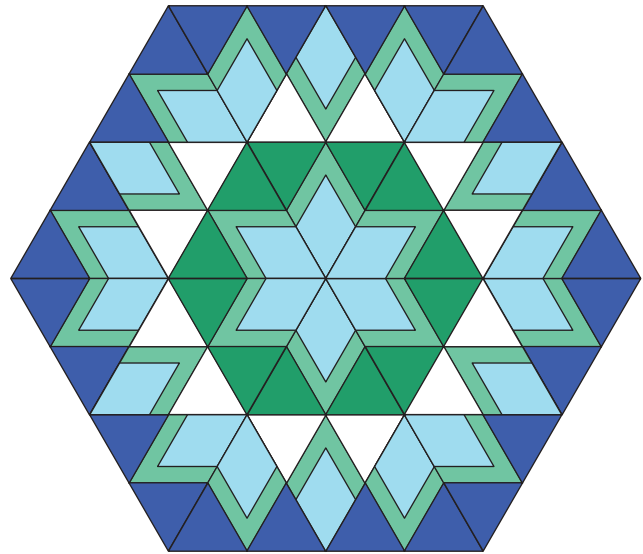
- Additional light source

Precutting for Class:

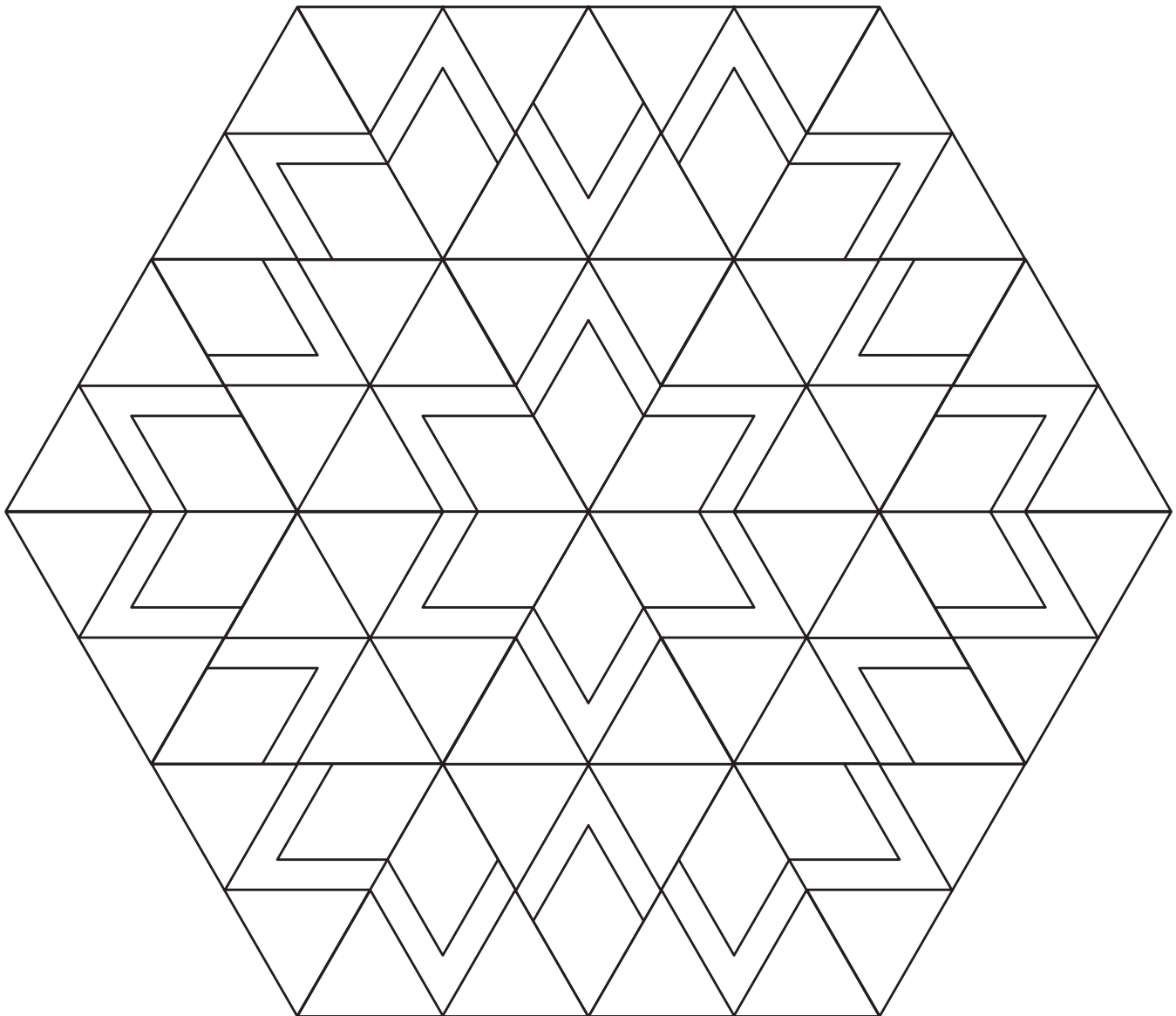
Refer to the blue and green project sketch.

Note: wof stands for width of fabric.

- Light blue diamonds 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof
- Medium green frames 6 strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof
- Dark green side triangles 1 strip $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof
- White side triangles 1 strip $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof
- Dark Blue side triangles 2 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof
