

Supply List for Parchment Pressing Patterns

- •**Fabric** the more variety the better! Pieces don't need to be larger than about an 1/8 of a yard. Make sure that you have a good assortment of values for each color. For example, if you have green fabric that you'll be using in your project, collect dark, medium and light green fabrics. (Fabric bundles are available at CollageQuilter.com)
- •Adhesive Double-Sided Fusible Web (Lite Steam a Seam 2). Please prepare a good assortment of fabric before class so that we can maximize class time working on our projects. I recommend applying SAS to pieces of fabric that are about 4.5" x 6". Not all fabric will need to be ready to use, but at least enough to begin the project. - <u>Fabric scissors</u> (Available for purchase at CollageQuilter.com). I recommend 6" scissors
- •<u>1/4</u>" Foam Core Board covered in felt (this is your work surface). Sold at local craft stores, it should be about 20" square (optional)
- <u>Parchment Paper</u> (baking paper)
- •Pins & Pencil
- •Iron A mini iron or wand iron is recommended
