

Supply List for an In-Person Class

Birds in Toyland, Needleturn Hand Applique

Fabric *I recommend that you pre-wash all fabric before class.*

- Background fabric: 10" x 10"
- A variety of scraps of cotton fabric in suitable colors for the class block
- A 10" length of ribbon or trim for the branch OR a 5" x 9" piece of cotton fabric.

\$5 Required Class Kit that includes:

- The 8" x 8" block pattern
- One 8" x 8" square of medium weight **clear vinyl**. If the vinyl comes with tissue paper, cut it with the vinyl.
- 1 sheet of **clear, heavy weight, single-sided, self-adhesive laminate**.
- An **ultra fine point Sharpie** marker in black
- One of my favorite needles and a toothpick.

Required Supplies for Class

You can find many of these supplies at pieceocake.com in the *Supplies for Class* section under *Shop*.

- Small **paper scissors**
- Small **fabric scissors**
- I will supply you with a needle but if you have needles that you prefer, bring them.
- **Applique pins**. Any of these pins will work in class: Clover's 3/4" pins, 3/4" pins from Little House, Bohin's 1/2" sequin pins, and/or Karen K Buckley's Shorter Perfect Pins.
- I will have Superior's Masterpiece, 50wt, 2-ply, 100% cotton thread for you to sew with in class.
- **General's charcoal pencil in white** for medium-to-dark fabrics.
- I use a **Blackwing 602 or Natural graphite pencil** for light fabrics. You will need a sharpener to go with it.
 - **OR** choose a Sewline or similar 9mm mechanical pencil in white and gray.
- A **sandpaper board** or a sheet of fine grain sandpaper.
- A **resealable bag** for your templates

Optional Notions

- A light and an extension cord in case the room is dark. Note that you may not be able to use this in some classrooms.
- Many people find that applique is easier if they have a Lap App or pillow to rest their forearms on. You can find Lap Apps at pieceocake.com.
