# Shaded Four Patch

Yet another great Tucker Trimmer technique to add to your bag of tricks!

Learn to create this versatile unit the Studio 180 way. Instead of squares and triangles, you'll use strip piecing and efficient construction to actually produce two units at one time. And of course, they will be oversized for accurate trimming to a precision shape.

You can expect to create numerous units in just a few short hours. The image shows just one of the possible configurations for a fantastic table runner.

The precutting requirements will create 16 units. Please arrive with all shapes cut and labeled so we can begin learning right away. There will be no time alloted to do this precutting during the class session.

The Tucker Trimmer® I tool and the Shaded Four Patch Technique Sheet are required for the class. The Quilter's Magic Wand™ is highly recommended.

#### REQUIRED EQUIPMENT AND PRECUTTING

Tucker Trimmer® I tool - required

Quilter's Magic Wand™ - highly recommended

Precutting to make a total of 16 units: From various bright colored fabrics For small squares:

Cut 4 narrow strips 2¾" x 12" For large triangles:

Cut 8 rectangles 5" x 6"

oita hackground fabric

From white background fabric

Cut 4 wide strips 3¾" x 12"

**Note:** To create the shown runner you will need a total of 56 units. That's three and one half times more than your class cutting requirements.



## **Equipment and Supplies**

### Required Tools:

- Sewing Machine in good working order (unless you are attending a machine sponsored class. Please check with your event coordinator for details)
- Neutral Colored Thread
- Cutting Mat-small to medium recommended
- General Purpose Cutting Ruler 6" x 12" recommended
- Basic Supplies such as Scissors, Pins, Seam Ripper, etc.
- Rotary Cutter new blade recommended
- Mechanical Pencil or Fine Line Marker

- Additional light source
- Chair pad or cushion
- Extension cord
- Camera
- Notebook & pen
