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Beneath the Surface – Supply list

Materials:

Makes three small quilts:

3, 12" squares backing fabric

3, 12" squares low loft white batting

3, 12" squares fine weave white fabric

2, 10" squares colored fabric

For facings:

12, 3 ½" squares backing fabric

12, 8" x 3" strips backing fabric

Optional: fusible web tape

Embroidery thread (8wt. perle cotton to co-ordinate with chosen colored fabrics)

White thread for quilting (50 or 60wt e.g. Aurifil on the Orange cone, Efina from Wonderfil)

Equipment:

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Iron and ironing board

Freezer paper

Pins

Sewing machine with walking foot (built in dual feed system works well... use a ¼" foot). Bobbin wound to match top thread.

80 sharp (Microtex) needle

pencil

Useful: lint roller, low tack painters' tape
