# Tropical Turtle and Fish Collage

Create two sea creatures, both the turtle and Barracuda to add to a tropical underwater scene. These simple collages using Jane's collage technique that uses no fusible or pattern pieces, can be used to make a pillow, tote bag or wallhanging. Be creative and have fun.

**The Kit includes:** the two patterns, Pellon 830 foundation and instructions.

## You will need to bring:

### Fabric:

For the Turtle, two 12" x 12" fabrics for the shell and the shell background, batiks work great for this project, 4-6 other small fabric pieces, approx. 10" x 6" for fins and head.

Barracuda, approx 6 pieces of fabric from small pieces including 2 larger approx. 12" x 6" for the fish body.

Batiks, Kaffes, small prints, tone on tone, textures, stripes and spots all work. Bring extra fabrics that you think might work as you can make small fish too.

### Fabric Collage Tools:

- Pencil
- Chalk marking tool, pencil or white pencil, or disappearing pen. I like the Bohin chalk marker.
- Fabric glue (I use Alennes Original Tacky Glue, the gold one) and applicator or I have these for sale \$1
- Good, sharp small scissors (I use Karen Kay Buckley 6" scissors)
- Small trash bag is useful
- Optional: Lightbox. Battery powered to work in the classroom
- Optional: Tweezers
