Teacher supply lists are generic - they include items that we either provide or are not permitted. Please do not bring individual irons, craft irons or any other type of iron to class. Please review the class info page on www.road2ca.com for more information. For Eudaimonia Studio's Villager Quilt workshop, you will need:

- Villager Quilt pattern
- Basic quilting supplies (machine, thread, needle, 6" x 12" acrylic ruler, 6" x 24" acrylic ruler, cutting mat, rotary cutter, pins, sewing clips, basting spray, iron, ironing board, soluble pen)
- Appropriate fabric for your desired final quilt size & variation (see tables below)

Note: Class participants should have all pieces cut out and labeled per pattern instructions for their desired size & variation, and bring their labeled cuts to class ready for piecing.

*Note on total colors required for Scrappy variation

For the larger sizes, you may not want so many different Non-Background colors; In this case, you can halve the colors and compensate by using ½ yd cuts of each color. For example, a Queen size could use (12) different ½ yd cuts of fabric, and a King size could use (16) different ½ yd cuts of fabric.
