Quilting Supplies

- Improv Patchwork: Dynamic Quilts Made with Line & Shape by Maria Shell <<u>https://talesofastitcher.com/improv-patchwork-dynamic-quilts-made-with-line-shape/</u>>
- Sewing machine with a straight stitch and a quarter-inch foot and/or the ability to create a quarter inch seam. (A quarter-inch foot with a flange will NOT work for sewing curves.)
- Rotary Cutter with a sharp new blade—Olfa 60MM Straight Handle Rotary Cutter (RTY-3/G) is preferred https://olfa.com/craft/product/60mm-straight-handle-rotary-cutter-rty-3-g/
- Rotary Mat
- Basic quilting supplies including straight pins, seam ripper, neutral thread, measuring tape, scissors, and snips
- Small sticky note pad
- Large notebook, sketch pad, or journal for making notes, sketches, and drawings about your quilt.
- Calculator and camera or smart phone that does those things
- Stiletto or Awl
- Small bag for trash/fabric scraps
- Painters tape

FABRIC – There are options. Please select one.

- 1. Create a palette of 6-8 colors that are dynamic together. You should have fat quarter to half yard cuts of each fabric.
- 2. Dig out your scraps! Larger scraps—approximately 5"x 5" or larger will work great for this workshop. It is more difficult to work with scraps, so keep that in mind.
- 3. You decide.

Please WASH and DRY all fabric that you will be using for this workshop. I know

you are going to ignore this request, but washed fabric is BETTER for our purposes. If you immediately remove the fabric from the dryer you can fold it without pressing. Of course, once you decide to cut into a fabric, you will be ironing it.
