Grow Wild Tote Workshop Supply List

For Eudaimonia Studio's Grow Wild Tote workshop, you will need:

- Grow Wild quilt pattern
- Basic quilting supplies (machine, thread, needle, 6" x 12" acrylic ruler, 6" x 24" acrylic ruler, cutting mat, rotary cutter, pins, sewing clips, basting spray, iron, ironing board, Hera marker or soluble pen, washi tape)
- (2) 25" long straps of choice: up to 2.0mm thick leather, cotton webbing, or pre-made
- (1) piece of plastic canvas or similar material at least 3" x 11½" for the sturdy bottom
- (2) pieces of batting, each measuring about 18" x 20"
- (2) pieces of backing fabric, each measuring at least 19" x 21" (this won't be seen)
- (2) pieces of lining fabric, each measuring 15¾" x 18¼"
- ¾ yd of background fabric, cut per the diagram below (see page 4 of pattern for lettered piece dimensions)
- The following *total* cuts (see page 4 of pattern for lettered piece dimensions) from six various fabrics (i.e., only one cut per fabric):
 - (1) B cut
 - (2) C cuts
 - (2) D cuts
 - (1) E cut

Note: Class participants should have all pieces cut out and labeled per pattern instructions, and bring their labeled cuts to class ready for piecing.
