Sarah Fielke 32 is a Bushel Material Requirements

Hi everyone! I'm looking forward to seeing you in class. Learn to make improv apples and a basket to put them in! No rules, no measurements - just relax, have fun and play!

There is a pattern fee of \$15, please bring it to class in cash.

Material Requirements

This list is the material requirements for the whole quilt, which finishes at approximately 58" x 75". Your quilt will not end up exactly the same size as Sarah's due to it's improvisational nature. We will get quite a few apples made in class and also start the basket.

Supply List:

- * Scraps of assorted red or green (depending on your apple variety!) print squares to total about 3/4yd (apples). You will need squares of fabric up to about 5in, smallest being about 3". The squares do NOT ne ed to be accurate or uniform.
- * Scraps of assorted green print fabrics or yardage to total about 3/8yd (leaves), neutral cotton thread for Sewing Machine
- * Assorted black or grey on white print fabrics to total about 2 3/4yd (backgrounds). I worked with 30cm (3/8yd) cuts of 10 different fabrics; this was more than is required for this project, but I found it h elpful to have options. Don't underestimate how much background you will ne ed for this class you may not need all 3 yards but you will need a generous amount of fabric, as improv takes quite a lot more that you wouldexpect.
- * 5/8yd brown print fabric (basket)

* I recommend you bring your own rotary, ruler and small mat to this class as there is a lot of trimming.

* All students must OWN their own copy of the pattern for class. Before class I recommend you cut your apple fabrics into rough squares as listed above. You will not need to cut any other fabric.
