



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A Paradise of Birds - Requirements

Pattern

The hard copy (\$25) and PDF (\$25) pattern are available from my website at www.focusonguilts.com.au

Background fabric

Background fabric for each block is cut at 12 inches x 12 inches. I used an assortment of background fabrics (photo above). <u>Birds, Flowers, Circles and Stems</u> I used an assortment of fabrics (see photo) – fat quarters are good.

Squares

A PDF is included with the pattern. Cut out squares and bring to the class. I used one green fabric for all my $\frac{1}{4}$ inch stems.

<u>Glue</u>

Roxanne's glue. I like the small bottles as they have a small spout which is easy to unplug if any glue gets stuck in it.



Clover Bias Maker

¹/₄ inch Clover bias Tape Maker and a metal pin (**not** with a plastic head as it will melt when pressing on it.



Needles

I use Jeana Kimball No. 10 straw needles but bring whatever needles you are comfortable with.



Circles

Karen Kay Buckley Circles



<u>Thread</u>

Good cotton thread – Wonderfil or Aurifil. I use Wonderfil Efina 60W in two colours





Fabric Markers

Frixion pens are great as they disappear with heat. I usually use the black pens. These are the two that I use. The retractable pens have



a fine point. Frixion pens are available are office supply stores (Officeworks) and some quilt shops.

You can also bring any fabric marker that you are comfortable with using.

<u>Spray Starch</u> Best Press – available at most quilt shops.

Washaway paper

Polyfuse – if it is available Hugs & Kisses Applique Paper

LIGHTBOX This is essential for the class.

Rotary Cutter, Ruler and Mat

All the other sewing notions that you would normally bring to a class.

<u>For the class</u> choose a couple of blocks to work on and bring all requirements (listed in pattern) to class.
