### **Quilting Supplies**

- Improv Patchwork: Dynamic Quilts Made with Line & Shape by Maria Shell <<https://talesofastitcher.com/improv-patchwork-dynamic-quilts-made-with-line-shape/>>
- Sewing machine with a straight stitch and a quarter-inch foot and/or the ability to create a quarter inch seam. (A quarter-inch foot with a flange will NOT work for sewing curves.)
- Olfa 60MM Straight Handle Rotary Cutter<<https://olfa.com/craft/product/60mm-straight-handle-rotary-cutter-rty-3-g/>> Is HIGHLY recommended for cutting without a ruler.
- Straight Rectangular Ruler (please bring one basic longer ruler, my favorite is the Omnigrid 4" x 14") < <http://omnigrid.com/quilting-sewing-supplies/rulers/omnigrid-standard-rulers/r14/>>
- Rotary Mat
- Basic quilting supplies including straight pins, seam ripper, neutral thread, scissors, and snips
- Measuring tape
- Small sticky note pad
- Paper and/or notebook and/or draft paper for making notes, sketches, and drawings about your quilt
- Calculator
- Design wall (a large piece of flannel or batting works fine) You will most likely not need this during a short three or six hour class, but you will need it once you start designing your composition.
- Digital camera or cell phone with the ability to take pictures
- Stiletto or Awl
- Small bag for trash/fabric scraps
- Painters tape

### **Fabric—PLEASE WASH ALL FABRIC PRIOR TO COMING TO CLASS**

—Eight 1/2 yard cuts of solid colored fabrics representing the color wheel—purple, blue, turquoise, green, yellow, orange, red, and pink AND Four 1/2 yard cuts of neutrals—white, grey, black, and brown

—Assortment of 1/2 yard cuts of stripes, dots, and other smaller prints

NOTE—Please work from your stash and pull fabric that you think you might want to use. The fabrics listed above are suggestions NOT requirements. If you want to be very basic in what you bring —just bring five fat quarters representing five different colors of fabric and we will go from there.
