Road to CA - Improv Angles & Shapes

Description:

Discover how ruler quilting can be flexible, fun, and full of creative possibility. Using a straight-edge ruler, stitch repeating lines, angles, and improv paths that add movement. Use foundational ruler quilting while experimenting with improvisational design. This class helps you create your own design rhythm without overthinking it. Start with structure, end with freedom.

Required Supplies:

- Fine Marking pen or pencil Chaco Liner Chalk Pen
- Marking Ruler, at least 12.5-inches x 3.5-inches
- Quilting Gloves
- Sew Steady Glider with a Square opening
- Quilter's Rule Straight Line Ruler, Mini Straight Line 10 3/4 MQT-MSLT Clear Acrylic Long arm 1/4 inch Link- https://quiltersrule.com/individual-product.php?id=313&tier=retail&category=21

Prepare Quilt Sandwiches:

Wash and starch fabric then cut:

Cotton fabric - Cut eight 12-inch x 10-inch pieces of solid, medium to dark Cotton batting - Cut eight 14-inch x 12-inch pieces of low/medium loft Muslin for backing - Cut eight 14-inch x 12-inch pieces

Panel Backing fabric:

Two low/medium loft cotton batting at least 14 x 14 inches Two backing fabric at least 14 x 14-inches
