Learn and master the technique of foundation paper piecing (FPP) while making the gorgeous hexagon quilt blocks and stunning borders of the All Together Now quilt. This class is best suited for open minded quilters who are ready to add a new technique to their tool belt. No previous experience with FPP is needed. We'll start with a presentation about how to apply color and contrast to the quilt blocks and borders. I'll then guide you through the steps of FPP with lots of tips and tricks as we make block #3 together.

Before Class:

- Order the All Together Now Pattern and supplies at SnapdragonQuilting.com/shop
- From the pattern, print or copy (6) triangle 1s on 20 lb copy paper or foundation paper, do not cut them out, we will do this together in class.

Materials:

- Pattern: All Together Now
- 2-3 fat quarters of colored fabric
- ¼ yd of background fabric

Note: FPP is easiest with fabrics that are the same on the front and the back, like solids and batiks, but I will show you how to use prints too.

- 50-80 weight thread that coordinates with the background fabric.
- Batting, backing, and binding are not required for class but will be needed to finish the quilt, see pattern for yardage.

Supplies:

- Pencil
- Glue pen or glue stick (washable)
- Tweezers
- Seam ripper (just in case!)
- Rotary cutter
- Small cutting mat
- Add a Quarter Plus Ruler
- Seam Roller
- Microtex (sharp) 70/10 needles
- 60° Triangle Ruler, optional
- Colored pencils
- Paper scissors
- Foundation paper or 20 lb copy paper
- Lightbox, optional
