Description:

Turn basic hexagons into dynamic quilted textures. We'll use a hexagon ruler set to stitch precise paths, layered motifs, and clever connections. I'll show you how to plan, mark, and move with confidence on your sit-down long-arm. Learn how to rotate, echo, and layer shapes. No math required—just fun, skill-building stitching.

Required Supplies:

- Westalee Design 3-piece Long arm 1/4-inch Hexagon template set https://www.sewsteady.com/product/simple-hexagons/ref/7/
- Westalee Stable Tape Dots (It's included with a "new" template) https://www.sewsteady.com/product/westalee-design-stable-tape-dots/ref/7/
- Westalee Design Spacing Gauge https://www.sewsteady.com/product/ westalee-design-spacing-gauge/ref/7
- Fine Marking pen or pencil Chaco Liner Chalk Pencil
- Marking Ruler, at least 12.5-inches x 3.5-inches
- Quilting Gloves
- Sew Steady Grid Glider with "square" opening

Prepare Quilt Sandwiches:

Wash and starch fabric then cut:

Cotton fabric -Cut eight 12 x 10-inch pieces of solid, medium to dark Cotton batting -Cut eight 14 x 12-inch pieces of low/medium loft Muslin for backing -Cut eight 14 x 12-inch pieces

Panel Backing fabric:

One low/medium loft cotton batting at least 20 x 20 inches One backing fabric at least 20x 20-inches
