Improv Log Cabins {workshop}

Description:

This workshop is your opportunity to try a new spin on the traditional log cabin block. You choose small or large scale. Then play with a variety of options including size of strips, background placement, and symmetry for your own unique improv log cabins. You can expect to construct one or more improv log cabins in class, depending on the scale you choose. Iterating on a design and quilting ideas will be discussed.



NOTIONS AND TOOLS:

- Neutral thread
- Scissors
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Acrylic cutting rulers (I prefer a 6 ½" x 24 ½" and a 2 ½" x 12 ½".)
- Straight pins (optional)

FABRIC:

Bring an assortment of coordinating fabrics. These can be scraps, a jelly roll, a fat quarter bundle, yardage, or a combination. Having at least 10-15 fabrics with a variety of values (lights, mediums, and darks) is a good starting point. For the option of creating log cabins with expansive negative space, bring 1-1.5 yards of a coordinating or contrasting background fabric. No precutting is necessary.
