Wonky & Curvy Cosmos

Full Day Workshop



Workshop Descriptive:

Liberated slash 'n sew strips come together in a traditional drunkard's path block to form the gorgeous, strippy, 22 inch diameter Cosmos circle. This workshop is perfect for beginning or advanced students to learn fun, easy and wonky strip piecing while conquering their fear of sewing curves with Linda's easy tips and tricks while making this artsy, improvisational Cosmos block!

Materials List:

• **"Cosmos" Pattern** by Colourwerx is included free with this workshop and will be handed out to all students on the day of the workshop.

• Fabric Requirements:

1. **For One (1) Cosmos Block (22" x 22") -**
 - a. **Background Fabric** - 1/2 yard

b. **Colored Strips** - choose 2 colourways (i.e.: red & purple or Pink and red, etc....) or scrap it up!. For a two color version - Gather (10) 2-1/2" X WOF (40") strips in each color group - make sure the strips vary in texture, tone and value - subcut each strip into 13" - 14" lengths for a total of (20) strips total in each color grouping. You will need (40) strips total to make one 22" Cosmos block for the class.

If you'd like to scrap it up, just gather (40) 2-1/2" x 13" -14" strips. You may use a strip roll (aka jelly roll) but prior to class, please cut the strips down to 2-1/2" wide x 13"-14" long. *Note: Strip widths can also vary from 2" to 2-1/2" or 3" wide - if you are pulling fabrics from your scraps.*

(In class - there may be an opportunity if time allows to begin a second Cosmos block so bring extra fabric if desired).

2. (1) Spool of Piecing Thread (aka Aurifil 100% Cotton 50wt Thread (or similar brand)
3. Regular Rotary Cutter Ruler and Rotary Cutter
4. 12-1/2" Square Ruler - **VERY IMPORTANT!**
5. Template Plastic or Heavy Cardboard to Cut Out Cosmos Pattern Shapes (from pattern)
6. Fabric Marking Pen (iron off or water soluble preferred)

A sewing Machine will be provided for you in class - however, you will also need these other sewing items to complete this project:

• Basic Sewing Supplies such as: straight pins (long glasshead pins work best), scissors, marking pencil or pen; seam ripper, etc...

Before Class:

1. Subcut your Fabric Strips into 13" - 14" lengths for a total of (20) strips in each of 2 colourways (or 40 strips total for 1 Cosmos block). Each strip should be approximately 2-1/2" wide x 13"-14" long. WE will cut the background fabric in class.
