Heirloom Handwork Textures

Learn these unique hand sewing techniques that will enhance your next quilt! These vintage sewing techniques will raise the surface of your quilt and truly impress. We'll learn Canadian smocking, hand pleating, ruching, and rouleau fabric manipulations, and then we'll cover how to put it into a block in your next quilt. Whether you are a traditional, contemporary, art, or modern quilter, you can add a cutting edge, yet classic, look to your next project. Great for beginners and experienced sewists.

Supplies needed:

- At least ten 8" squares of good cotton fabric in solid or solid like colors
- one fat quarter of good cotton fabric in solid or solid like colors
- a clear plastic ruler at least 8 inches long (like Omnigrid rulers)
- strong thread to match your fabric (I like 40 or 50 weight threads)
- scissors and thread snips
