Student Supply List

Art clothes or apron and comfortable shoes
2 plastic tote bins and lids – Approximately **24" x 18" x 6"**
Craft scissors
Permanent marker
Roll of paper towels



We will complete 90% of this project in class, but there will be rinsing and washing assigned as “Homework.” We are, after all, holding a dye class in a rather unusual location. Don’t fret - this is actually the fun part where you get to see your results!

Each facility is different, and some are more prepared than others. I have learned the quilters who take my classes are adaptable and resourceful and find the experience and resulting stash well worth it!

We will wrap your project up in the bin, with lids on each dye tub for safe transportation. There will be a few flat bed carts available, but many students choose to bring their own.

This is a 6 yard rinse that can easily be accomplished in 45 minutes to an hour, depending on your pace and color choice. Detergent is provided. It can be completed in as soon as 3 or 4 hours, but can also be done the next day.
