Midnight Hex: Fearless Foundation Paper Piecing

Road2CA 2027 Supply List

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Learn the fundamentals of foundation paper piecing (FPP) while creating stunning hexagon-shaped star blocks. No previous FPP experience is required—just a willingness to learn a fun new technique! Along the way, we'll also explore how color, value, and fabric choices can dramatically change the look of your quilt. **Everything in pink is clickable.**

Materials:

- **Pattern:** Midnight Hex quilt pattern ([printed](#) or [digital](#) version)
- **Foundation Paper Piecing Templates:** Templates for both class blocks are included in the class kit.
- **Coloring Pages:** [Free printable coloring pages](#) are available for planning your layout, color placement, and quilting motifs.
- **Fabric:** Bring 3–5 fabrics in ¼–½ yard cuts or scraps from your stash. Solids and batiks are easiest for learning FPP because most don't have a right or wrong side. Prints work beautifully too and I'll show you how to use them successfully. Refer to the pattern for yardage requirements if you plan to make additional blocks after class.
- **Thread:** Coordinating thread—[DecoBob](#), an 80 wt thread, is great for FPP

Supplies:

Road to California does not allow participants to bring irons to class. Sewing machines are provided.

- Pencil
- Colored pencils
- Paper scissors or a rotary cutter reserved for paper

- [Basting glue](#) (washable glue stick)
- [Rotary cutter](#) for fabric
- [Add-a-Quarter Plus](#) ruler
- [Small cutting mat](#)
- [Seam roller](#)
- [Seam ripper](#) (Just in case!)
- [Lightbox](#) (optional but helpful)

Before Class:

1. Order the [Midnight Hex quilt pattern](#) or purchase it in class.
