Class requirements for The “B” Bag

- sewing machine, extra needles, thread, bobbins, scissors
- Cutting board, rulers and rotary cutter
- iron and ironing board

Special class related items:

- interfacing for bags - such as Soft and Stable - or a large piece of batting

Fabric:

- **main fabric (first side)** - 1 1/3 yard of medium weight fabric for the Maxi size bag, 1/2 yard for the Midi size bag, and 1/3 yard for the Mini size bag.
- **lining fabric (second side)** - 1 1/3 yard of medium weight fabric for the Maxi size bag, 1/2 yard for the Midi size bag, and 1/3 yard for the Mini size bag.
- **Binding** - 2/3 yard quilting cotton for the Maxi size bag, 1/2 yard for the Midi Size bag, 1/3 yard for the Mini size bag.
- **Interfacing or batting** – 2 x 24” x 24” pieces for the Maxi size bag, 2 x 18” x 18” pieces for the Midi size bag, 2 x 12” x 12” for the Mini size bag. Soft & Stable is recommended but a sturdy type of batting can also work.

Pattern:

- The “B” Bag: Patterns will be available for purchase before class, a pattern is \$10 for class participants.

In this workshop you will learn:

- how to sew a French seam;
- how to seamlessly attach bias binding on tight curves;
- how to make a fun and easy reversible beach bag.
